



Exhibitor Terms and Conditions

Delivery

- Exhibits should be delivered to St Boniface Church, Bunbury on the **22nd of June 2026 between 1pm and 5pm or on 23rd June between 6 and 8 or by arrangement.**
- Exhibits should be unwrapped & ready to hang. **Framed pictures need to have a hanging cord on the back.**
- Submitted exhibits will be subject to Final Review by the curator. If it is judged that any work is not suitable for hanging for whatever reason, you will be asked to collect this work.
- **No responsibility will be taken for damage to unselected works that have not been collected.**
- While exhibits are in the Church for the exhibition they are insured by Ecclesiastical Insurance

Artwork

- **No clip frames** will be allowed. All work should be safe ie. No sharp edges, no loose parts etc.
- **Labels: A label needs be stuck on the back of the artwork with the artist's name title and price.**
- **Large Artwork:** Please ensure that on larger artworks your frame is stable and safe enough for the artwork. Although we will enjoy having some big pieces of work, our acceptance may have to be limited due to space. **Artwork may not be accepted over 1m in any direction including the frame.** Any exceptions to this will be at the judges' discretion.
- **The entry fee is £5 per artwork payable when the artwork is delivered to St Boniface**
- When you submit your form either by Jotform link <https://form.jotform.com/260133504093346> or via email (if by email please attach a Jpeg image of each piece you wish to put in the exhibition). Each Jpeg file must have the title and dimensions of the work and your name. This is to enable us to keep track of images for each artist.
- Artworks are selected based on artistic quality and to allow for a range of styles and subject matter
- These images will be subjected to a First Review.
- **The judges' decision is final.**

Entry

Commission	<p>Buyers will purchase work directly from St Boniface Church</p> <p>The artist will be paid the sale price less 20% commission within 30 days of the exhibition. Exhibitors should take this into account when pricing their work.</p> <p>Payment will be by bank transfer.</p> <p>After the exhibition bank details will be requested from any artists who have sold their work.</p>
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Collection of artworks	<p>Artworks should be collected at the close of the exhibition on Sunday 28th June from 4pm to 6pm, or on Monday 29th June from 10am to 12 noon or 4pm to 6pm</p>
